Forest Schools

Forest School sessions will be offered to those children who start primary school in September on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday afternoons week beginning Monday 12th May for 4 weeks. Please note that the forest school group does not get back to nursery until 3pm, we cannot make this any earlier. Sarah Capper is our forest schools trained leader, and she will be leading these sessions. You will receive a letter about this if your child is going to school this September and attends for a minimum of 2 days a week.

Sports Coaching

Sports coaching provided by Max from Galactica coaching will continue to take place every Tuesday morning for the children going to school in September. It is particularly important that your children arrive promptly at nursery by 9.15 am on these days dressed in tracksuit bottoms/leggings and trainers.

Getting ready for school meeting

Please let us know when your child's primary school place has been confirmed. We will then liaise with the feeder primary schools. The reception teachers will all be invited to Flagg to meet your children in a familiar environment before they begin their visits to primary school.



In order to make the transistion to Primary School as easy as possible for our children we have bought them all a "Buddy Bear." The Bear will go with them to primary school but before then we will be planning activities around the bears in the Summer term to introduce the children to the idea of "Big School."

All parents of children going to primary school this September 2025 are invited to a meeting either on Monday 12th May at 6.30pm or Tuesday 13th May at 9am.

We will talk about the Buddy Bear project and about how to help your child with the move to primary school. Practitioners from the Changing Lives project based at Lady Manners School (positive mental health support) will be at the Tuesday morning meeting to answer any questions and address any anxieties you or your child may have about starting school.

Parent: teacher meetings

There will be parent teacher meetings on 13th and 16th June where you can discuss your child individually if you have any specific concerns. These meetings are for the parents of ALL children, not just the children going to school this September.

INSET Days

There are two remaining INSET (in service training) days this academic year, which will be on:

Tuesday 6th May and Thursday 24th July

School will be closed to children on these days for staff training. This year staff training has included safeguarding, cyber security, GDPR, maths, Smart board techniques, SEND (special educational needs and disabilities) teaching, Makaton (sign language) and improving children's language skills.

Summer Dates

- **Big Toddle**, Tuesday 10th June, 12.30pm. Every year we do a sponsored walk over the fields to Monyash where we have a play in the park and an ice-cream. This is to raise money for Barnados, teaching children to help those who are less fortunate than themselves. You are all very welcome to join us and accompany your child, even if they don't normally attend on Tuesdays.
- **Sports day and family picnic** at Taddington School Tuesday 17th June from 12.30pm. If the weather is bad on the 17th June, we have a backup date of Tuesday 1st July. All welcome whether your child normally attends on a Tuesday or not. You will receive a consent letter about this shortly.
- School trip to Matlock Farm Park: Thursday 26th June all day. This trip is for all children. Bears will be supervised by staff but Cubs will need to be accompanied by a parent or other responsible adult. Nursery will be closed on this day except for breakfast club as all staff will be on the trip.
- **Leaver's assembly** for children going to school this September and their parents: Monday 21st July 2pm.
