Communication between school and home

Everyone has joined Class Dojo where we post photos of what the whole class has been up to, videos of stories and songs and ideas about home learning (it's like a class blog). Each child also has an individual portfolio where we can post photos and videos just of your child. You can comment in the class blog and also in your child's portfolio where you can post photos of your child at home so we can talk to your child about things they have achieved outside nursery school.

You are very welcome to discuss any concerns or questions you may have with staff at the beginning or end of any session in person. If you need a longer, more confidential chat please let us know. Staff are always available in person, via telephone, video call or e-mail. If something is bothering you then let us know straight away and we will deal with it immediately.

Remember, if something significant is happening in your child's life, let us know so that we can support them eg the death of a pet, a poorly grandparent or maybe they have been awake since 4am and will need a sleep!

Governors Section

The two committees of the Governing Body (TLC: teaching, learning and community links committee and RMC: resource management committee) met on Wednesday 29th November.

The Governing Body supports the head teacher in running the school by monitoring standards of education, finances, safeguarding provision, SEND (special educational needs and disabilities) provision, health and safety and the site itself. If you feel that you could spare six evenings per year to support the school to benefit the children and the community, then please let me know. We are a very friendly and effective team and welcome new members warmly.

One of our governors, Mr Peter Swann, successfully applied for a Tesco grant for us in order to pay for dance sessions and sports sessions over the year. A big thank you to Peter for this, the children are really enjoying Jenny's dance sessions and I am sure they will also benefit greatly from the sports sessions starting in January.

Due to the constant reduction in real terms funding from the Government over the past twelve years we are operating with fewer staff for fewer hours and experiencing other cost inflation. Because of this, the governors have decided to enforce a late charge for anyone regularly picking up late ie after 12pm or 3.15pm. We are happy to run a flexible pick up from 3 to 3.15 as we recognise that many of you have children at two schools so being in two places at once is impossible. After this time however, we need to pay for staff to stay longer if children are still here so we will be implementing a late charge of £10 to cover this. At lunchtime there is a rota in place for staff to have a lunch break which makes it difficult to look after children whose parents are late so the same late charge will apply after 12pm for those attending morning sessions.

Governors would also like to thank the Parish Council and Mark Ramsden from Grafika for the new road signs asking drivers to slow down. We have tried to have the speed limit around nursery reduced from 40mph to 30mph to no avail so hopefully these road signs, designed by Flagg Nursery School children in 2017, will make the roads in Flagg a little safer for our children.

Parent Pay

All charges for this term will be on ParentPay by 10am on Thursday 21st December. Please ensure that all balances are cleared before we return to nursery on Monday 8th January.

Bad Weather

If there is a heavy snowfall and we think that travelling to Flagg will be dangerous for parents, children and staff, we will send out an e-mail and a message on Class Dojo as soon as possible. We will also endeavour to have someone answering the school phone from 8am if you want to call. If you think the roads are dangerous the advice is: If in doubt don't set out. If it snows during the day and we are worried about children getting home safely we will follow the same procedure.
