Safer Internet Day



Save the date! Friends of Flagg Easter Bunny Drive and Easter Egg Hunt



The Friends of Flagg Easter Bunny Drive will be held on **Thursday 30**th **March from 3.30pm until 5pm.** Tickets will be on sale in nursery from 13th March, £2.50 per person. There will be an Easter Egg treasure hunt, snacks to buy and then a Bunny Drive: like a beetle drive but with a picture of a bunny. The idea is that you throw the dice and if you get a 6 you collect a head, 5 a body etc. The first team to get a full bunny wins the prize.

We will need donations of chocolates and Easter eggs in advance for prizes, also cakes, buns and biscuits or healthy snacks on the day. We always need lots of volunteers, both on the day and beforehand. If you can spare some time to get involved with our friendly group then please let me know.

Parent Consultations

Most of you have had the opportunity to come in to nursery school for a parent consultation. If you have not managed to book one and would like to speak to us about your child's progress, please let me know. We are always available for a chat and this can be via telephone or Zoom if you can't make it into school.

Our curriculum and assessment documents are on the website for you to look at. We assess children every six months against typical development for their age. If they are working below age-related expectations then we put interventions in place eg ECAT (every child a talker) or specialist SEND (special educational needs and disabilities) support. If they are working above age-realted expectations then we make sure that we provide them with appropriate challenge.
