The next full Governing Body meeting will be held in school on Wednesday 7th February. The Governors will discuss the school's SIP (School Improvement Plan) and look at the school budget to ensure that the school is providing value for money.

At the last Governing Body meeting it was decided to put up the fees in September 2024 by 50p per hour for 3+ year olds and 25p per hour for 2-year-olds. The charging and remissions policy and our charging structure can be found on our website.

The Governing Body also decided to issue a late fee from January 2024 for anyone who is late when picking up their child because this has an impact on staff lunchtimes at 12pm. At the end the day it has an impact on staff's ability to prepare for the next day. These charges will be added to your parent pay account.
