### Breakfast Club and other charges

The nursery session starts at 9am. You are very welcome to drop your child off before 9 but there is a charge for breakfast club of £6.50 for an hour or £3.25 for up to half an hour. At the moment we do not charge when children are picked up after 3pm as we have had a flexi pick up in place. Please be aware that we may have to charge for this from September.

If your child is attending for a morning the pick-up time is 12pm. Please ensure that you are on time as staff only have 30 minutes for their lunch, if you are 10 minutes late that means they only have 20 minutes for their lunch.

### Big Toddle

This year we are supporting Barnados by organising a sponsored "Big Toddle." On Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> June we will walk to Monyash over the fields, play in the park and have an ice-cream. Hopefully the infant class at Monyash school will join us for an ice-cream and a play. We will leave nursery at 12.30pm after dinner. Please ensure that your child is wearing suitable shoes for a countryside walk.

### School Trip: Crich Tramway Museum

I have booked a school trip to Crich Tramway museum on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> June. We will leave nursery at 9.15am, arriving about 10.00 am. Children in Bears class will be accompanied by staff but children in Cubs class will need to be accompanied by an adult. All children are welcome on this trip even if they don't usually attend nursery on Wednesdays. The trip is free to children but we will need a contribution from accompanying adults. **Please pay for this on Parent Pay now if an adult is accompanying your child.**

Please note that nursery will be closed on this day as all staff will be on the trip. Breakfast club will be open as usual.

### Sports Day and Family Picnic

We will be holding a sports day and family picnic on Tuesday 4th July. At 12.15 pm we will walk up to Knotlow farm: you are welcome to meet us there at 12.30. There will be no school dinners on this day so all children will need a packed lunch. All children are welcome, not just those who attend on a Tuesday. There will be races and sports toys to play with. If the weather is bad on 4th July, we will postpone until 11<sup>th</sup> July





### Leaver's assembly

There will be a final singalong and presentation for parents of children leaving us this year at 2pm on Wednesday 19th July. All welcome, including children leaving in July who do not usually attend on Wednesdays.

### September sessions and School Dinners

We have sent out a letter about sessions for September asking you to let us know which sessions you would like, please do this by Friday 16th June. If there any siblings not yet registered to start nursery in September or January, please let us know now.

Please note that there will be no school dinners in September. The service costs the school £6,500 and because our governors decided to pay for free school meals out of our school budget this adds another £1,500 (free school meals are not paid by the government for nursery aged children even if they are entitled to them). As I'm sure you are aware, all public services are receiving less money than previously and we are no different. Our budget has been substantially cut over the last few years we can no longer afford this service.

**All children staying all day will therefore require a packed lunch from September.**
