<p>Week beginning 3rd June Summer books Pirate books Adventure stories</p>	<p>Create a Pirate ship with the wooden indoor climbing frame Make and write in Father's day cards (Lit focus- name writing) Black paper and chalk to create flags (small individual ones and a large one for the ship) Beebots using treasure map and blocks to create our own roads Maths focus: How many animals will sink the boat (tally/mathematical mark making) Small world pirates Mark making in cornflour in the clear tray Treasure in the sand Wooden blocks to build a ship and walk the plank Den building with sheets</p>
<p>Week beginning 10th June Pirate books Dad/ Grandad books</p>	<p>11th July (Tuesday) The Big Toddle to Monyash Finish making and writing in Father's day cards Lit- Create a WANTED poster in groups Maths: garden trail Stories about Dads, Grandads, Uncles and families Treasure hunts in the garden Water play- exploration, watering plants and paintbrushes/ buckets</p>
<p>Weeks beginning 17th June Castle, knights, dragons, princesses, king stories</p>	<p>Woodwork 1-1 sessions Turn the wooden frame into a castle Fairy dust sensory writing tray Maths: The doorbell rang: sharing and subitising Wooden blocks to build castles Frozen castle and Frozen characters in the water Fairy land small world Create fairy doors in the garden Drawing dragon prints Making treasure maps, treasure hunts in the garden (positional language)</p>
<p>Week beginning 24th June Castle, knights, dragons, princesses, kings stories</p>	<p>26th (Wednesday) school trip for Bears class to Peak Wildlife Park Stories and songs about animals around the world, habitats, diet and characteristics Drawing animals that we saw at the wildlife park Hammer and nail set to create shape pictures, shape songs, tessellation, explode a square, symmetry Dragons and horses in the sand Fly swatting paint in the garden Making potions in the mud kitchen and writing recipes (emergent writing and writing numerals)</p>
