
The clip above shows the story of the animals who raced across the river and how the Chinese Zodiac was named after them.



Think about the ordinal numbers the clip talks about (1st, 2nd, 3rd). Get some of your toy animals and have a race and see who will win, come 2nd etc. Put them in the right order. For the voice sounds aspect of letters and sounds (early phonics) see if you can make the noise each of the 12 animals make in the story- can your grown up guess which animal you are?

WEDNESDAY

Listen to one of the teachers read 'Cleversticks' on class dojo.



In nursery, we will be thinking about things we are each good at- can you ride a bike, count to 10, do a forward roll, put your coat on...? We will then all draw a picture of us doing the thing we are good at, why not do one at home! Ask everyone in your family what they are good at, guess what their answers might be!

THURSDAY

Fish is seen as a lucky food to eat during the Chinese New Year celebrations. Attached to this is a craft idea to make your own lucky fish. Show us a picture of your finished art work- hope they bring you luck!



Try putting your fish on the floor and see if you can get it to move- how could you do it? Could you blow under one side of the fish or use a book or newspaper to waft air around it? Which method works better? Can you think of another way? Look on dojo for one of the teachers reading a story about a fish.
